PROJECTS/PROJECT UPDATES

- **Cleanouts Maintenance:** is in process and being evaluated and scheduled based on greatest need.
- **Security in the community** is being evaluated. Bushes to be trimmed to lower levels and junipers removed to improve visibility and safer grounds.
- **Parking lot striping:** to be reviewed and scheduled as funds allow in 2024.
- **Groundwater-flow improvement project:** areas are being reviewed for excavation and repair to address flooding problems during weather precipitation events..

COMMON QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

How can we help reduce water costs? Your ongoing maintenance helps control water costs. Repair leaky, dripping faucets immediately. Replace old toilets with the new lower water usage models. Collectively these will make a big difference in our water expenses.

Who is responsible for the outside water spigots? The maintenance guys will take care of spigots and will remove covers when appropriate. Please DO NOT touch these, as they are disappearing and replacement is costly.

How can we keep our mail safe? Getting the mail each day is the best way to protect yourself. Check mailboxes & take packages <u>every day</u> so thieves don't have the chance to steal. The postal office has posted an alert with regard to identity theft and how to help prevent it by getting your mail sooner than later.
